Program:

Two days, 20 April and 21 April are reserved for oral presentations. The poster session will be organized on 20 April, in the afternoon. Every half-day section of presentations will start with an invited lecture.

On the last day of conference, 22 April, optional half-day excursion to the Brno Reservoir and the Veveří Castle with an educational lecture is planned.

How to contribute:

We require that the first author of each contribution have to be student or early-career scientist (\leq 3 years after PhD. defence).

Oral presentation:

Presentations from any discipline of both geosciences and biosciences, which are focused on Polar, or Alpine regions research are welcomed. Oral contributions should fit to 15 minutes for presentation + 5 minutes for discussion. We accept only presentations, which are held in English. In the case of excessive number of oral presentation, the organisers reserve the right to shorten the length of contributions, or change the oral presentation to a poster. In that case, participants will be notified by an e-mail.

Poster presentation:

Presentation from any discipline of both geosciences and biosciences, which are focused on Polar, or Alpine regions research are welcomed. 5 minute will be given for every poster presentation. We accept only posters written in English.

Abstract:

Abstract are required to be written in English and meet the following criteria:

Format:

- MS Word document (*.doc, *.docx)

Obligatory parts:

- Title
- Full name of author(s) and email address to corresponding author
- Affiliation(s)
- Keywords (max 6)
- Text maximum 1000 words (500 words is recommended)

Optional parts:

- Figures max. 2, png or tiff, at least 300 dpi for photographs and 600 dpi for drawings, send as separate files
- Tables max. 1, in MS Word or MS Excel format.
- References (max. 5 in Harvard style)
- Acknowledgement

The abstracts will not be peer reviewed, however the organisers reserve the right to require correction if English or some of Obligatory/Optional part will not have required quality.
